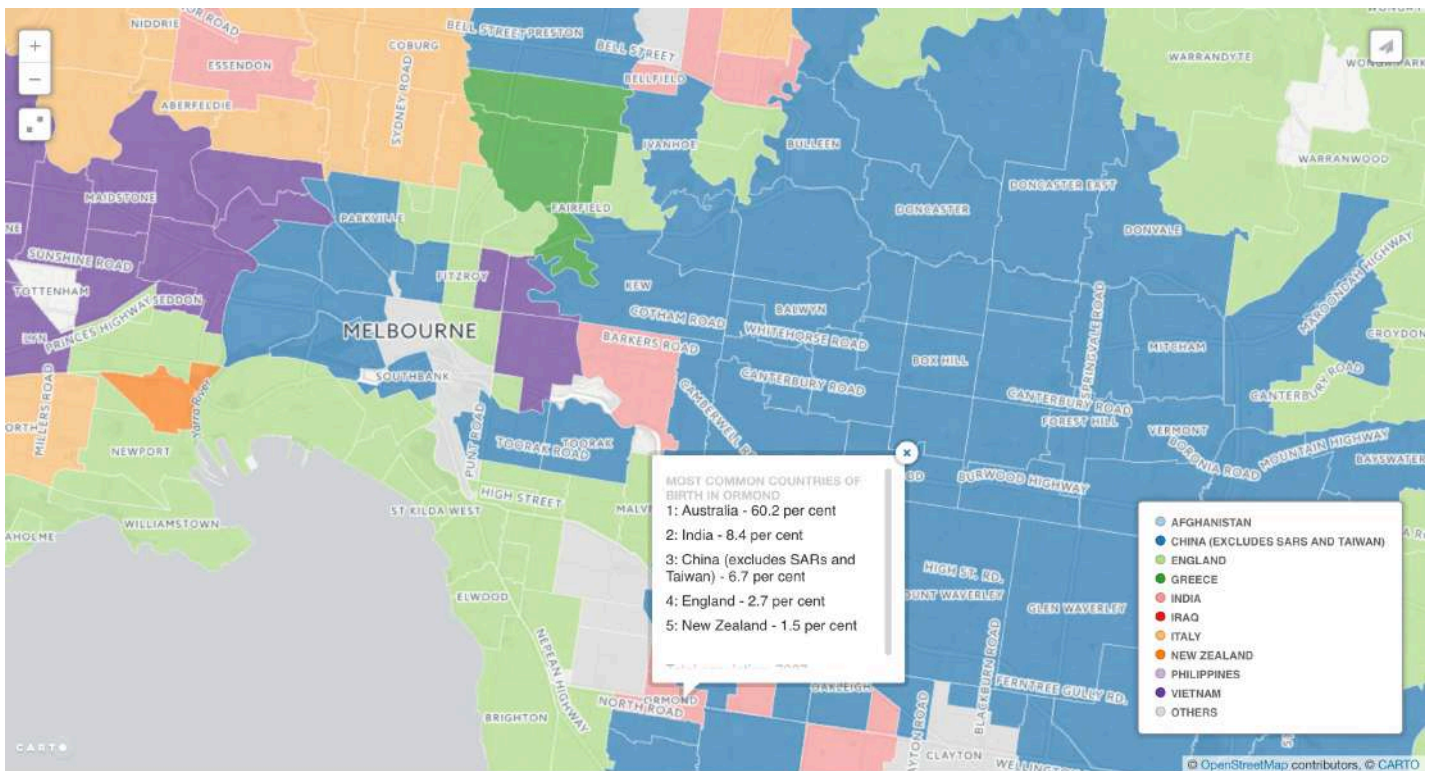


Melbourne's Migrants
